



NEW FRONTIER NURSERY



Your child will love to visit the New Frontier Nursery! . Let your child enjoy a fun, safe and social environment while you work out! A waiver form must be completed by the parent/ guardian prior to the child being allowed in.. We require the parent or legal guardian remain in the facility while children are in the nursery.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Monday—Thursday	8:00am—1:00pm & 3:45pm—8:00pm
Friday	8:00am - 1:00 pm & 3:45pm—7:00pm
Saturday	8:00am-1:15pm
Sunday	10:00am-1:00pm

GOAL

To provide your child with a safe and clean environment where they can play, have fun and enhance social skills.

AGES & TIME

We will care for children 3 months to 9 years of age for a maximum of two hours. Children not walking must wear socks and all children walking must wear shoes.

SECURITY

Children will be released only to those individuals who initially dropped them off. Individual must be 18 years of age to pick up a child from the nursery. An ID may be required at the time of pick-up. Any special circumstances will be at the discretion of the nursery staff.

STAFF

All of the nursery attendants at the New Frontier Nursery are CPR/1st Aid Certified within the first 3 months of employment. They are experienced in child care and enjoy working with kids.

RATIO

- 1 nursery attendant to 10 toddler/children
- 1 nursery attendant to 5 infants

PAYMENT INFORMATION

We have drop-in and punch card options available. Payment needs to be made at the front desk. A receipt must be given to the staff when your child is brought into the nursery. Payment for time used in the nursery is determined in 15 minute increments. There is a 7 minute grace period. At 8 minutes an additional 15 minutes will be charged.

FEES

Drop-in fee: Residents

\$3.25/hour for one child

\$3.00/hour for additional children
(same household)

Drop-in fee: Non Residents

\$4.25/hour for one child

\$4.00/hour for additional children
(same household)

20- hour punch cards available. Hourly Rate is discounted with the purchase of a Punch Cards.

Discount child care rate available for annual and 6-month pass holders:

\$60.00 unlimited child care for the year for the 1st child

\$30.00 unlimited child care for each additional child. (same household)

SNACKS

You are welcome to bring a small snack for your child. No snacks are provided by the staff. For the safety of all children, **no nut products of any kind are allowed**. Please label all personal items brought into the nursery.

POTTY TRAINING

Please let us know if your child is potty training. We will take your child to the restroom at predetermined intervals. We do ask that your child is in pull-ups or plastic pants to prevent accidents. Please label all personal items brought into the nursery.

SICK CHILDREN

We appreciate your cooperation in leaving ill children at home to prevent the spread of illness to other children or staff. Please keep your child home if they have experienced any of the following symptoms in the previous 24 hour period: Stomach ache or nausea • Vomiting • Inflamed eyes • Sore throat • Diarrhea • Chills • Earache • Fever • Skin rash or sores • Heavy Nasal Discharge • Cough or cold less than 4 days.

ELECTRONICS

The staff is not responsible for lost or damaged devices. Everything must be "g" rated. Music must be listened with headphones only. We do not allow any picture taking, Snapchat, or Instagram.

NOTIFYING PARENTS

When you sign your children in the Nursery, please indicate on the sign in sheet, where you will be within the facility. This will assist us in contacting you if needed. If a child has been crying continuously for 10 minutes, the staff will contact the parent for pick-up

DISCIPLINE

Discipline is determined by what is age appropriate for the child. In most cases, talking with the child and redirecting their activity or behavior is all that is needed. Time-outs will only be used in circumstances where an older child intentionally hurts another child or ignores repeated requests to change behavior or action. The nursery attendants will be responsible for documenting and informing the parents of any behavior that has occurred.
